On Saturday, November 7, 2009, Hurricane Ida ravaged the country of El Salvador. So much rain fell in such a short period of time that mountain streams turned into raging torrents. People were swept away by the muddy waters. Hundreds are dead, hundreds more still missing and thousands are left homeless and destitute. The storm wiped out the harvest. Those in rural areas have lost everything. It will take months before another harvest can be gathered. The situation is desperate for the next several months.
