We want to remind everyone of the changes to our Christmas Shoebox Project. Our desire is to be as effective as possible. We want to be able to reach as many children as we can. We always run out of gifts; there's never enough. We hope by streamlining our list and collecting specific items and boxes, we can reach more and be more of a blessing. Please review the list below, and follow the guidelines as closely as possible. We appreciate your cooperation and your willingness to give. God bless you!



The Shoebox – Smaller boxes are preferred.

- They are easier to transport.
- When distributing, it's easier to be fair to the children.
- We can reach more children with many smaller boxes than just a few children with larger boxes.
- Plastic containers with lids are great.
- The shoebox or plastic container with lid size s/b 12"L x 6"W x 6"H.



Infant Box – This list is a guideline

Bar of soap, shampoo, baby lotion, diaper cream, baby brush, 1 baby bottle, teething ring, t-shirt, socks, bibs, spoon, pacifier, baby wipes, cereal, and a Salvation Tract. A package of diapers can be taped to the top of the box. **Please, it's important that your box is full.** Clearly mark the top of your box "Infant" with black marker, attach to the lid an envelope containing \$2 or more to help with shipping, and secure the lid with 3 large, thick rubber bands.



Boy Box – This list is a guideline

Bar of soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, wide tooth comb, 1 pair of socks, 1 pair of underwear (size does not matter), matchbox car, baseball, yo-yo, action figures, small flashlight with batteries, pencils, pencil sharpener, pens, small thin coloring book, crayons, balloons, stickers, candy & snacks (i.e. all kinds of candy, fruit snacks, snack crackers, raisins, etc.) a kid's Salvation Tract. **Please, it's important that your box is full.** Clearly mark the top of your box "Boy" with black marker, attach to the lid an envelope containing \$2 or more to help with shipping, and secure the lid with 3 large, thick rubber bands.

Girl Box – This list is a guideline

Bar of soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, hairbrush, 1 pair of socks, 1 pair of underwear (size does not matter), a small "Barbie-type" doll, play jewelry, fingernail polish, small purse, colorful hair accessories, pencils, pencil sharpener, pens, small thin coloring book, crayons, balloons, stickers, candy & snacks (i.e. all kinds of candy, fruit snacks, snack crackers, raisins, etc.) a kid's Salvation Tract. **Please, it's important that your box is full.** Clearly mark the top of your box "Girl" with black marker, attach to the lid an envelope containing \$2 or more to help with shipping, and secure the lid with at least 3 large, thick rubber bands
