



### Unit #82 is Completed

The construction of the Mobile Surgical Clinic for Nigeria, Africa is completed. We give God all the glory! This unit is amazing, if we do say so ourselves. It's a complete operating room, triage and prep room inside a 30ft. box truck with awnings and add-a-rooms off the sides. A 12KW generator provides power to the lights, air conditioners, air purifier, water filtration system and all the medical equipment inside. It has water tanks, a water heater, refrigerators and more. There are custom cabinets providing ample storage of supplies along with countertops and sinks. There are two entries – side stairs and a rear ramp. This clinic will be able to provide medical care in the remote regions of Nigeria, Africa. Normally when we finish a unit, it ships right away. We are so excited to be able to tour with this clinic before it ships to say “thank you” our churches and businesses for their support and partnership with our ministry and share what God is doing with BUSES International.

A couple of Saturdays ago, the doctors and other professionals from 100 IGBOS, the ministry who will use the clinic in Nigeria, flew into town to see the clinic. We had a small dinner and ceremony where we officially handed them the keys to the clinic. It was so great to meet these men and women who have such respect for Christ and such passion to help the needy men, women and children of their homeland. We were moved by their testimonies. Many came to the U.S. in the 70's during the civil war in Nigeria where appalling atrocities took place. These men and women were able to escape those horrors and endeavored to get an education. They became doctors, surgeons, nurses, engineers, teachers and other professionals succeeding through hard work and dedication. They have organized themselves together as Nigerian-Americans to go back to their homeland and make a difference among the Igbos people in southeast Nigeria. We listened and learned of the difficult challenges they face in order to minister love and care to the sick and dying, and we saw the determination they have to make an impact for God. We were thoroughly impressed by their plan of action and their past ministry achievements. BUSES International is honored to partner with 100 IGBOS to demonstrate the love of God in Nigeria. There are still many obstacles to overcome. The negotiations with the Nigerian government are still ongoing, but we did have a significant breakthrough. The Consulate General of Nigeria from the embassy in New York City travelled to Ohio to meet with 100 IGBOS and BUSES International. He came to our facility in Lorain and toured the clinic. Before departing, he announced that he would be sending a letter of support to the officials in Nigeria recommending that they approve the passage of the clinic and allow it to enter the country duty-free. This is a tremendous step! If the clinic gets approved “duty-free”, it will give us more low-cost options in shipping it overseas. There are still many details to work out, so will you pray with us? We need men and women of God to pray for BUSES International, 100 IGBOS and other ministries and organizations caring for the sick, feeding the hungry, and ministering to the hurting, needy and oppressed around our world. Will you please pray?

There is so much work still to do, yet God continues to call families and churches to respond to the need and be a blessing. You are one of those who God is using. Each dollar you give to BUSES International, each donated item, each volunteered-hour served is powerful and makes a difference.
